One more time THANKS SO MUCH, hundred of people have now been able to wear shoes thanks to you, there were some people who never had wore shoes. Many people from far away have visited me at the church asking for shoes and clothes, some time there are not one pair of shoes that fit to them, it maybe fit to one member of their family.



We had some clothes and toys and were given at the same time, also we took this opportunity to pass the word of God to the people, and each family received literature of the Bible. Through this I have made some contacts to continue studying the Bible.

We visited several places at Tegucigalpa area, Villa Vieja and Villa Nueva, poor people live on these communities and I though it was the best place where to put this blessing.

When I visited other churches I usually brought with me some shoes and the persons I saw who did not have shoes they received one pair.



On one place you see pictures of children receiving shoes. These children do not have their mother alive, and they do not their father also, they live with their grandma, an old woman who can not survive for herself. She depends on others. Those children's mother died from AIDS, they live far away from the city of Tegucigalpa at a remote area named, Cocepcion de Pespire, I started a church close to that community but still it

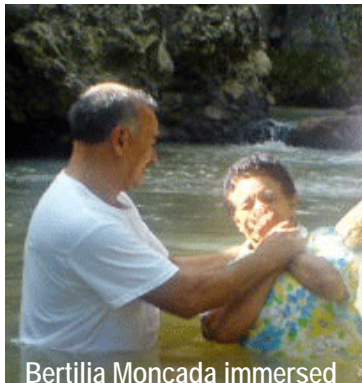

is far away for those children to visit the church.

Grecia Baca is from Concepcion de Pespire, Choluteca, from the same community of the children whose mother died of AIDS, she grew up there and went to school which covers until grade 6, then if they want to continue in high school they have to walk at least two hours to the bus station and from there to school take some 30 minutes by bus, the same on the way back home.

The road is dirty road and for teenagers is dangerous, so for that lack of opportunity she immigrated to the city of Tegucigalpa to continue in high school.

One day in Tegucigalpa, it was a Friday evening she was coming from school, suddenly the bus stopped and the bus driver told the passengers that the bus did not work, the bus is a public transportation for everybody, So everybody got out of the bus but five men retained Grecia inside the bus and abused her sexually.

As consequence of that she became insane, lost equilibrium and did not recognize anybody, someone told me and I took her to the hospital to see a Psychiatrist, she was put into the hospital and received some mental attention.

After two month she recovered and from that time she has been coming to church where love was showed to her. Then she decided to be baptized into Christ.

Her mother decided not to report to the police what happened because she was afraid of those men.

We have had three baptisms this month. Bertilia Moncada belonged to New Life church founded in Brazil, now she is a member of the church of Christ. Marta has been grown in the church. And Grecia Baca is from Concepcion de Pespire, Choluteca.

Thanks you to you and all ones involved in this tremendous effort.
